1 President's Address

- The President, Prof John Wang, called the meeting to order at 8.22pm.. He extended a warm 1.1 welcome to the members and thanked them for their presence and continued support of SPEA.
- He informed members that of the demise of Dr Lau Teng Chuan. Prof John Wang then went on to 1.2 cite the various contributions of Dr Lau to the fraternity. Prof John Wang also informed that SPEA plans to expand on the LTC Development Fund.

- 1.3 He informed the members that SPEA committee members put in time and effort to sell and deliver the Lau Teng Chuan Autobiography in support of raising funds for the LTC development fund. SPEA received \$6,200.00 in donations and \$10,498.00 from the sale of the books.
- 1.4 Lau Teng Chuan also donated a lump sum of \$21600 to NTU/NIE to establish a LTC book prize.
- 1.5 SPEA is currently in the process of starting the Lau Teng Chuan Scholarship Fund in memory of the late Dr Lau and to support aspiring sports professionals to continue Dr Lau's legacy to build a stronger sporting culture in Singapore.
- 1.6 Prof John Wang informed members that a talk was conducted by the 6th E.W. Barker Visiting Professor Stuart Biddle from Loughborough University in February 2012. The talk was entitled "The Role of Ohysical Activity in Positive Youth Development and Mental Health"
- 1.7 Prof John Wang informed members that a workshop entitled as "Evolution of Science and Development of Players in Football" was conducted 17 September 2012 at ITE College East. A total of 42 participants attended the workshop conducted by Dr Paul Ford from Liverpool John Moores University.
- 1.8 Prof John Wang informed that 28 PE teachers and 6 officers from MOE participated in the trip to 2012 AAHPERD Convention and Exposition organized by SPEA in collaboration with PESTA. A survey was conducted at the end of the trip and participants agreed on a scale of 3.5 out of 4 that they had learnt and can apply what they had learnt to their work.
- 1.9 Prof John Wang informed that the SPEA Vision, Mission were revised. The changes were printed for all present at the meeting. The changes to the constitution were accepted

- 1.13 In 2012, SPEA engaged Mr Li Chunxiao as Secretariat support to facilitate more activities and make the running of these activities more effective.
